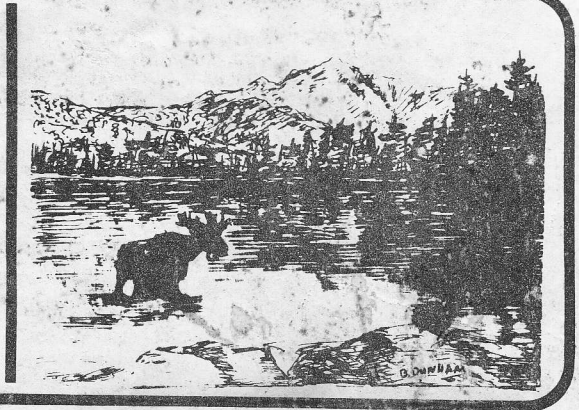

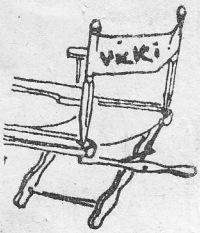
"HI EVERYBODY!"
