May is National Bicycling Month, so come on out and join us for some "bike celebrating."

The bike program offers something for everyone. Call the leader if you've got any questions. Don't put it off - pick a trip and call now - they fill fast! To help you choose a trip suited to your biking abilities and interests, here's a guideline to our trip rating system.

Beginner: up to 15 miles, 2 or more hours.

Geared to riders with very little cycling experience. Frequent stops.

Easy: 15-25 miles. Slow to moderate

pace, with a few hills.

Interm.: 25-30 miles. Moderate pace,

occasional hills.

Advanced: More than 50 miles, fast pace

and/or very hilly.

General Info about bike trips:

• Please preregister for all trips with leader or co-leader.

• 10 speeds desirable, but many trips OK for 3-speed. Check with leader.

 Helmets suggested, but not mandatory unless specified by leader.

 Children are welcome when accompanied by adult, but must be OK'd by leader.

• Bike should be in good working condition. Carry pump, tools, spare tube.

 Dress for weather. If weather is doubtful, check with leader.

SASE = stamped, self-addressed envelope.
 May be required to get trip details.

• Charge for non-members: Daytrips \$1. Weekend/longer, \$1/day.


